CareDx is developing additional products for transplant monitoring using a variety of technologies, including AlloSure[®], a proprietary next-generation sequencing-based test to detect donor-derived cell-free DNA after transplantation.

CareDx, with its presence through Olerup, also develops, manufactures, markets and sells high quality products that increase the chance of successful transplants by facilitating a better match between a donor and a recipient of stem cells and organs. Olerup SSP[®] is a set of HLA typing used prior to hematopoietic stem cell/bone marrow transplantation and organ transplantation. Clinical Laboratory Assistant (Tuesday- Saturday 11PM to 7:30AM)

The Clinical Laboratory Assistant (CLA) performs a variety of laboratory and administrative tasks to support the clinical laboratory staff in the CLIA-certified CareDx laboratory. A CLA performs laboratory duties under direct and constant supervision of a licensed CLS or the Clinical Laboratory Manager (CLM) and/or designee, who provides specific instruction regarding how tasks are to be completed and defines the steps to be employed.

Job Duties:

- Perform patient specimen processing under the direct and constant supervision of a licensed CLS.
- Perform routine laboratory maintenance tasks and setting up consumables in preparation of laboratory testing.
- Assist the CLS in laboratory testing.
- Receive and accession samples into the laboratory information management system (LIMS) to facilitate sample throughput.
- Perform instrument calibrations and maintenance.
- Perform data entry and maintain spreadsheets
- Participate in materials management activities which includes tasks such as ordering, receiving, unpacking, documentation and labeling of consumables and reagents, and stocking work areas.
- Participate in quality control and quality assurance activities.
- Perform testing for special research and development studies.
- Comply with CareDx quality control policies and document QC activities

- Maintain confidentiality of personal health information (PHI).
- Identify problems that may affect assigned duties, and following established protocols, correct problems or escalate to Clinical Laboratory Scientist, Clinical Laboratory Manager, or lab Director.
- Document corrective actions taken when test systems deviate from established performance specifications.
- Perform additional administrative duties and projects assigned by the Clinical Laboratory Manager.
- Comply with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations governing clinical laboratory operations.
